WOW Camping Email Message


We are excited to welcome you to this year's 2021 Win on the Wabash Super Raffle Event (WOW) scheduled for August 27th and 28th at Ambassador Park in historic Ft. Recovery, OH.

If you have received this email, you have an email address for a registered campsite(s) for the event and we are looking forward to seeing you. If you need to update the email address, or if you no longer wish to retain your campsite, please respond back and let us know, as they are currently sold out with people wishing to get a spot.

We have been working closely with Ambassador Park (the home of the WOW) and are excited we have been able to make a number of improvements to the camping area including adding gravel to the driveways, leveling a large section of camping, and adding a large number of additional future electric sites. Unfortunately, we are at the mercy of mother nature and the grass that was planted in May will not be ready in time to allow camping on this new section for this year's event. An announcement on the availability to purchase these will come sometime later this year for the 2022 event.

Below is important information that we ask you read closely to help prepare you for this year's event. We recommend printing this off and bringing it along as reference. Thanks!

Arrival Times for Campers

- Wednesday August 25th 6:00 PM 8:30 PM
- Thursday August 26th 6:00 PM 9:00 PM
- Friday August 27th 9:00 AM 10:00 AM
- Because of bridge weight limitations we have a limited window to allow for campers to arrive. If you do not arrive during these times you will not have an opportunity to camp on site. No exceptions and no refunds.

Special Considerations

- In preparation for the event and because of bridge weight restrictions, campers will not be able to arrive after Friday August 27th at 10:00 AM or be removed before 6:00 AM on Sunday August 29th. No exceptions! Plan accordingly.
- We do not have any designated handicap camping sites available but will do everything we can within reason to accommodate. Contact us via Email at camping@wowraffle.com of those requirements by August 14th to work out the details.
- When you arrive to park your camper, you will receive a Camping Permit/Parking Pass. After initial arrival date, only small trucks and cars can access the campsite via the bridge accessible from SR 119. You must have the Camping Permit/Parking Pass visibly displayed to access the campsite. This will be closely monitored so **don't forget your pass.**

Camping Site Arrangements

- Electric Sites: With the improvements made to the electric campsites we will not have reserved spots this year. We will be directing you to a location and parking you as you arrive. Your arrival date and time does not necessarily mean you will get the closest spot to the event.
- Primitive Sites: No reserved spots for primitive camping. Because of the increased number of campers this year, we are expecting a full campground area. You will be assigned a space when you arrive and, in many cases, it may not be the next closest spot to the main event entrance.
- If you want to camp in a group, then everyone in the group must arrive at the same time. We will not be able to hold spots.
- All campers must park within marked site boundaries. This includes the vehicle pulling the camper. Overflow camper parking will be available for vehicles that won't fit inside the site boundaries.

Camping Rules and Guidelines

- Check website for all official rules and updates. www.wowraffle.com
- You must have a WOW ticket to enter campsite.
- Must be 18 years of age or older to enter the campgrounds and/or WOW Super Raffle event.
- Only one vehicle per reserved campsite. Your camper, vehicle, and all belongings must fit inside the
 designated camp area. Vehicles that do not fit within the camping space will need to park in designated
 parking areas.
- Sites may not be level; campers are required to bring plenty of blocking.
- For the reserved electric sites, campers to supply all proper connections.
- Only single axle trucks without trailers and cars will be permitted to cross bridge to enter and leave campgrounds.
- Campfires are prohibited. Charcoal cooking is OK provided it is disposed of properly and safely.
- Set out trash in sacks each morning by 7:30 AM for pickup. Pickup all trash before leaving.
- No Glass, Fireworks or Soliciting in camping or event area is permitted.
- Quiet hours are from 1:00 am to 7:00 am. No use of generators or music during this time.

- **Absolutely no golf carts, ATV's, UTV's, SxS's, etc.** will be allowed on Ambassador Park Grounds.
- No food or drinks allowed to be carried into the Super Raffle event. Food and drinks available for purchase.
- Pets are not encouraged at campsite. Service animals only will be allowed at Super Raffle event.
- Showers (limited) and portable restrooms will be available. Shower times will be Friday from 6:00 AM until 12:00 PM, Saturday 6:00 AM until 10:00 AM, Sunday 6:00 AM until 12:00 PM.
- No dump station available on site. Mike's Sanitation will be available on Saturday morning from 5:30 AM 7:00 AM if dumping is needed at the owner's expense.
- Not responsible for injuries, accidents, and damaged or stolen property.
- For an emergency dial 911, location of Ambassador Park at 2205 St. Rt. 49 in Fort Recovery, OH along with a description of where you are located on grounds.
- The WOW Super Raffle Committee reserves the right to have any unruly campers, visitors, etc. removed for any reason. There will be no refunds for any purchases during or prior to the event.
